

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(COLESDEN ROAD, COLESDEN) ORDER 201*

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Bedfordshire in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby direct as follows:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as “Bedford Borough Council (40mph Speed Limits) (Colesden Road, Colesden) Order 201*” and shall come into operation on the xxth day of (month) 201*

Length of Road in Colesden

40mph Speed Limit

That length of Colesden Road which extends from a point approximately 86 metres north-west of the common boundary of property nos.1 and 2 New Farm Cottages in a generally easterly direction for a distance of 1208 metres.

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE SPEED LIMIT CHANGES IN COLESDEN

Reason for the proposal: The proposed Order is considered necessary on the grounds of promoting road safety. The proposal is part of a Borough-wide initiative to introduce lower speed limits.

Effect of the Order:

To introduce a 40mph speed limit on the following length of road in Colesden:-

That length of Colesden Road which extends from a point approximately 86 metres north-west of the common boundary of property nos.1 and 2 New Farm Cottages in a generally easterly direction for a distance of 1208 metres.

Statement of Reasons

The proposed Order is considered necessary on the grounds of promoting road safety. The proposal is part of a Borough-wide initiative to introduce lower speed limits.

The proposed 40mph speed limit covers that length of Colesden Road from a point approximately 86 metres north-west of the common boundary of property nos.1 and 2 New Farm Cottages in a generally easterly direction for a distance of 1208 metres. This should reduce vehicle speeds through the main built-up part of the hamlet.
